



## USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES

1. No mobile phones to be used on school property (including playing fields).
2. No earphones to be used on school property (including playing fields).
3. Laptops (to include Ipad, netbooks, android devices etc) are an aid to teaching and therefore are only to be used on the instruction of the teacher. Exceptions to this are when Sixth Form students are in the Study Centre and all other devices are in use. Usage of laptops in the Study Centre is to be monitored by the *On Call* member of staff.
4. Laptops can be used in the Library by authorisation of the librarian. Mobile phones and music devices are not to be used in the Library.
5. Music is not allowed to be listened to in any lesson, including Private Study.
6. Phones can be used within lessons only when applicable to the lesson, and when specifically authorised by the teacher.
7. As per the 'Commitment to Form Period' document, mobile phones should not be used during form period.
8. Sixth Formers may use mobile phones in the Coffee Lounge during break, free periods and lunchtime only. It is the students' responsibility to ensure that usage is contained solely within the Coffee Lounge and that there is no "spillage" into corridors, the Atrium or the Study Centre. *Should anyone be found to be flouting this rule, the privilege will be removed entirely.*
