To be eligible to receive a bursary the student must be aged under 19 on 31 st August in the academic year in which they start their programme of study and must satisfy residency criteria

Funding may be withdrawn for students who fail to attend regularly, fail to make reasonable progress or fail to comply with the School's standards of behaviour.

When approved, the bursary will be paid by instalments each term (3 times per year). The bursary may be paid 'in kind' - e.g. the school may purchase bus passes, equipment etc. Cash payments will be sent by BACS to your Bank Account. Receipts must be retained

Applications for financial support should be submitted to the School by the start of the academic year although it **may** still be possible to apply for funding after this date. The School will allocate the majority of the Bursary Fund in September, but will retain a small amount to cover late applications, unexpected costs or changes of circumstance.

If you want help with transport costs from the 1st day of term, you must complete and return this form before the end of August and apply to Lincolnshire County Council for transport.
