Our School Day

Each student has an individual timetable showing all the lessons you will have over a 2-week rolling cycle. This will change at the beginning of each academic year.

You can see on the example timetable below, that our school day starts at 8:55am. You are expected to be lined up outside your classroom with your books by then.

You then have a 6 period (lesson) day, each lesson lasting 50 minutes. A bell will sound to indicate the end of lesson. Our school day finishes at 3:30pm.

At the end of your second lesson you will move to your Tutor Time, which is with the same Form Tutor throughout your time at SGS.

There is a 15 minute break at 11:00am and you have 5 minutes in which to gather the books you need and move to your next 2 lessons.

At 1:00pm you will hear the bell sound for lunch which is 45 minutes, again allowing 5 minutes to get your books and make your way to your final 2 lessons.

Some subjects, such as PE and Technology, require a double lesson.

You will quickly become familiar with your timetable but staff and other students are always about to help you.

Our Houses

Bentley - named after Richard Bentley, Headmaster 1681 and a notable academic of the English Enlightenment

Gamlyn - named after John Gamlyn who procured 'letters patent' to found SGS in 1588

Hobson - named after John Hobson who left money for the School in his will

Johnson - named after Maurice Johnson, founder of the Spalding Gentlemen's Society

Moulton - named after Moulton Grammar School, founded in 1562 and amalgamated with SGS in 1939

Wykeham - named after Wykeham Abbey
