

## EPQ Transition work 2025

- 1) A- Read the two examples of a thesis, as attached to the uploads,\* for the transition work.

Sample one: *'The Impact on Human Rights of the UK and US Legal Response to Terrorism'*

Sample two: *'What makes an effective advertising campaign nowadays?'*

(\*Please note we follow AQA exam board. The exemplar materials are just to demonstrate the EPQ components and what a final thesis can look like).

B- Write at least one side of A4, about **each** thesis, to reflect on 'what went well' for the candidate and how it could be improved with 'Even Better If' comments to **evaluate** the response to the question proposed. Does the candidate develop and realise the **objective** of their title?

- 2) Now, you can **think of three potential working titles** for your own thesis for the Extended Project Qualification.

In September, you will need to arrive to the first lesson with a selection of potential working titles.

For each title-

- Explain why you think this would be an interesting title,
- What you could potentially research,
- How you would create an investigation to explore two sides of this debate.
- What would they entail and why?
- Where would you start to research your information to form these lines of argument?
- Make a note of any initial sources ie; books, journals, articles, weblinks, key scholars.

You should write at least **one A4 side for each prospective working title**.

**Minimum hand in: 5x sides of A4 work for both sections.**

You will need to submit your reflections and proposals in the **first lesson**.
